IMPORTANT 2018-19 REMINDERS

Tuition is due by June 1, 2018, for families who selected the payment in full by this date. Tuition for students in grades K-8 is \$4,020. Tuition paid after this date will be \$4,120.

If you are signing up for a Monthly Payment Plan through Unity Catholic Federal Credit Union, **final documents for the June 1st payment plan are to be signed no later than May 18th**. If you are doing an August 1st tuition payment plan, the documents must be signed by July 20th.

For students in the preschool program, tuition deposits (\$500 for full day and \$350 for half day) were due by May 1st. If you have not yet paid your deposit, please do so as soon as possible.

Tuition balance is also due by June 1st for the preschool program.

If your student is not returning to IWA next year and you have not yet confirmed this with the school, please notify Mrs. Konopka or Mrs. Fenton as soon as possible. Also, if you are not returning and have not yet completed your request for transfer of records form, please email sfenton@incarnatewordacademy.org. Mrs. Fenton will email you the document.
