Soil Exploration in Third Grade



Miss Grusenmeyer's third grade scientists examined two soil specimens through observations and discussions in a collaborative lab. They discussed with their lab partners the quality of the soils, added water to each soil sample and observed the effects, and used descriptive language when sharing their observations of what type of soil each sample was. Students compared density, color, and absorption and developed conclusions of which soil is more nutrient rich.


