Weaving in the Design Process in Primary







Spooky Spiders in Second Grade

Second grade students have been learning about different types of engineers and how they use the design process. The students were challenged to create a spider web using only four pipe cleaners and three yards of yarn. This spider web needed to prevent fake spiders and cockroaches from falling through the web. After planning and building their design, the webs were tested to see if they met

the challenge. Some webs needed to be improved and redesigned. The students spent time afterwards analyzing their designs, considering how effective they were in preventing the spiders and cockroaches from falling through the web.

Ms. Marsico's class used the Design Process to create a Monster Trap. The students began by listening to the story, How to Trap a Monster, which provided some great ideas. They sketched some designs and then built their traps. The process included a lot of glue, tape, markers, and stickers. The traps will be set out tonight!


