Sixth Grade Investigates in the Lab

Students in sixth grade learned that minerals can form when elements or compounds dissolve in hot water and then crystallize when cooled. In this lab, students created a base on which to grow their own crystals using a solution of distilled water (heated to 80-85 degrees Celsius) and sodium borate. The end-

product will be a priceless Christmas ornament.

Cross Curricular Learning



First Grade students have been learning about the artist Piet Mondrian. They are designing and building 3D works of art by creating a cube with popsicle sticks and tissue paper based on Mondrian's work. The final step will include making the artwork "come alive" by creating a simple circuit with conductive tape, two LED lights and a battery. Third Grade Jewelry Design



Third grade students were tasked with designing an abstract flower drawing that had to be symmetrical. The finished designs were then sent to the Glowforge laser printer to create pieces that were used to make necklaces.
