KINDERGARTEN SCREENING

Screening for Kindergarten will take place on Monday, March 10 and Tuesday, March 11 in St. Joseph Hall. If you have a child who does not currently attend IWA that you would like to enroll in Kindergarten for the 2025-26 school year be sure to sign up for a time slot using the link below.



Areas of assessment are Physical Development, Language Development, Academic Skills/Cognitive Development, and Self-Help and Social-Emotional Skills. The purpose of the screening is to determine strengths, opportunities for

growth, and to provide you with some activities that you can do with your child over the summer to help him/her be ready for kindergarten in August. The screening will take approximately 45 minutes to complete and we ask that a family member remain at St. Joseph Hall while screening is conducted.



Track & Field - Boys and Girls Grades 1 - 8

Track season is fast approaching and there has been a lot of interest so we wanted to share some information for those who were considering joining the team. The season will begin the first week of March and run through mid-May.

Varsity track (grades 5-8) has practice Monday, Wednesday and Thursday from 6:00 pm until around 7:15 pm. Juniors (grades 1-4) will practice Monday and Thursday from 6pm-7pm. Initial practices will be held inside St. Joseph Hall but will move outside once the weather warms up. Outdoor practices will alternate between the tracks at TRI-C West (off of York Road in Parma) and Berea Midpark Middle School (Paula Road in Middleburg Heights).

Meets generally begin the first week in April. Juniors have six meets on Saturday mornings and Varsity has seven meets on Sundays.
