Warrior Design Process in First Grade

Students in Ms. Vacanti and Ms. Schieferle's classes have been using the Warrior Design Process to improve the depth of their learning.

Ms. Vacanti's class had a community partner visit from Scholastic, sharing her career as a curriculum salesperson. The students learned about the needs of her customers, then then applied this knowledge to create their own business, named the 101 Curriculum Group. Their business focuses on the development and sales of math manipulatives that target first grade standards. Students collaborated in computer class to design personalized business cards, then worked in the Innovation



Center to make a collaborative light-up logo utilizing the Warrior Design Process. I had the pleasure of hearing their sales pitches and have decided to purchase their products. Great job, 101 Curriculum Group!

Both classes have been learning all about dental hygiene this month. The students had a visit from Mrs. Hribar, our STEAM Building Coach, to learn about the history of the toothbrush! Did you know that the earliest twig toothbrushes date back to 1600 B.C in China? After learning about the evolution of the toothbrush, the students were challenged to design and draw what a toothbrush might look and function like in the future. Students also used the Warrior Design Process to create Tooth Fairy traps after reading How to Catch a Tooth Fairy! Based on their designs, they are thinking she is very tiny. They also speculate

that she has never been caught and they are confident that their designs will be successful.




BUTTERBRAID FUNDRAISER
